

Information on the Entry and Post-Entry Procedures for Students of Chosun University

☐ Precautions for Re-entry to Korea

※ Re-entry applicants must enter the KakaoTalk group chat before entering the country!!

※ Submission of COVID-19 test results after entering Korea

– 1st step: Visit Dong-gu Health Center after entering Korea, PCR test → Capture PCR test results, and submit photos

– 2nd step: Examination with a self-diagnosis kit on the 6th day after entering Korea → Submit a photo of the test result of the self-diagnosis kit

※ Applicants for the 2nd semester of 2022 must be the holder of Q-CODE issuance and must be exempt from self-isolation.

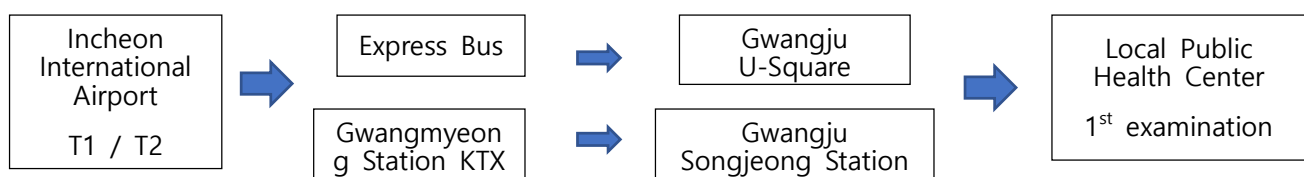
☐ **Q-code(Pre-Quarantine Information System) registration**

1) Required document: Personal information, PCR test negative confirmation (test within 48 hours of departure date), vaccination certificate (within 180 days after 3rd or 2nd vaccination), passport, flight ticket, etc., and certificate are attached

2) Exemption from quarantine is not applicable 180 days after the 2nd inoculation (non-administered) and 7 days of self-isolation after entering the country

3) **Even if you are exempted from self-quarantine, you must take a post-entry examination (2 times)** (1st: public health center / 2nd: self-diagnosis kit)

Recommended to board an arrival flight before 2 p.m. in consideration of travel time to school (or home)

1. Notifications

1) **All foreigners entering the country are obligated to submit a PCR negative certificate when entering the country(as of 22.5.11.)**

- Submission criteria: **Confirmation of inspection within 48 hours of departure date**
- Inspection agency: All inspection agencies are recognized, but original submission in

English

※ Presented by the airline when boarding the flight (not allowed if it is misplaced), original submission at the quarantine stage after arrival

2) Pre-entry supplies: self-diagnosis kits, food and emergency supplies

3) Procedure for responding to COVID-19: Contact the International Cooperation Team (062-230-6497) > Home Treatment > Call 119 if symptoms are severe, contact the International Cooperation Team

4) The 2nd semester of 2022 will be held as a face-to-face class, so you must enter the country a week before the start of the semester.

2. Other notifications

- If there is no vaccination or Q-CODE, self-quarantine must be carried out. In addition, please note that the student is responsible for all disadvantages such as claims for damages due to failure to comply with the guidelines and judicial processing during the quarantine period.
- The school complies with the policies of the Ministry of Education and Gwangju Metropolitan City Hall, and the self-quarantine plan is likely to change from time to time to ensure the safety of international students, so visit (eng.chosun.ac.kr or chi.chosun.ac.kr) Please reconfirm the notice before entering the country, and as always, we ask for your active cooperation.
- Public health center operating hours: 09:00-11:30 / 13:00-17:00 (visit the public health center the next day after 17:30)
- Please go home after the examination, wait at home until the results come out, and check the negative results before going out.
- **Information on the burden of treatment costs if COVID-19 is confirmed**
 - Countries that support foreigners (including Koreans): Full support (excluding non-essential non-benefits).
 - Non-supported countries for foreigners (including Koreans): Full responsibility for their own expenses.
 - Country of conditional (partial) support for foreigners: Quarantine room admission fee (bedroom fee) is provided, but the cost of treatment, food, etc. is borne by the person.
