

Procedures for Chosun University international students before and after entering the country

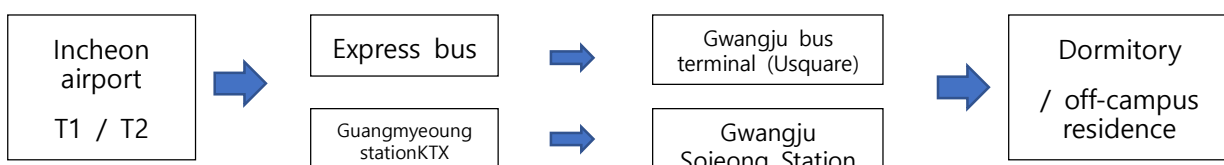
□ Precautions when entering Korea

- ※ Re-entering students must join the KakaoTalk/WeChat group before entering the country!!
- ※ Must prepare a self-test kit, emergency medicine, and mask before entering the country, .
- ※ Be sure to check the notice on the International Student website (eng.chosun.ac.kr).

- Considering the travel time to school (or home), it is recommended to board the flight arriving **before 1pm** if possible.
- Students staying in the dormitory must arrive at the dormitory before 6 p.m.

1. Reminders

- 1) International students must check airline regulations and school notices before boarding the plane.
- 2) What to bring before entering the country: self-test kit, mask, groceries and emergency medicine.
- 3) Procedure for responding to corona diagnosis after entering the country : Contact the International Affairs team (062-230-6497) > Home treatment
 ✧ If the symptoms are severe, contact 119, contact the International Affairs Team.
- 4) All international students (Enrolled, Re-enrolling, Graduating) are required to enter the country before class begins (2023.03.02.)
- 5) Dormitory entrance: 2023. 02. 28. (09:00 – 18:00) / Additional charges for advance entry.
 - Global House: KRW 9,000/day
 - Baek-hak-hak-sa, Global House: KRW 7,000/day

2. Note

- Please note that the student is responsible for any disadvantages such as claims for damages due to non-compliance with the regulations of the Korean and University quarantine policies, and for judicial proceedings.
- As quarantine policies may change to ensure the safety of international students and comply with the policies of the Ministry of Education and Gwangju Metropolitan City Hall, be sure to **double-check** the notice on the international student website (eng.chosun.ac.kr) before entering the country,

- **In case of testing positive for COVID-19, the cost of treatment will be borne**
 - Foreigners-Supported countries (including Korean nationals): Full support (excluding non-essential, non-wage)
 - Foreigners from non-supported countries (including Korean nationals): All expense self-paid.
 - Foreigners from countries with Conditional (partial) support: The cost of admission to the quarantine place (hospital room) is supported, but one is responsible for cost of treatment and meals.
