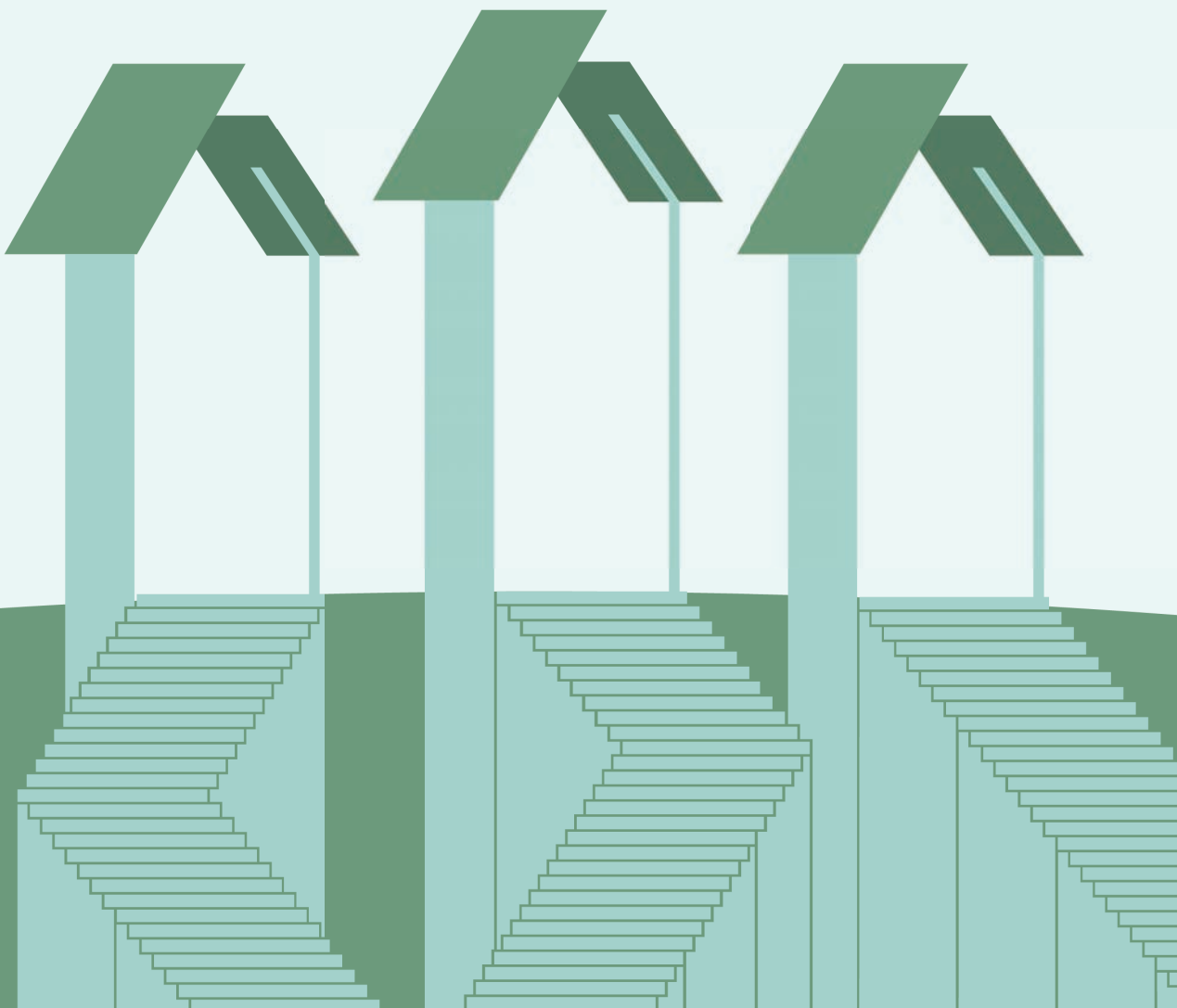

- 4) In addition to the specified documents to be submitted, additional documentary evidence necessary for confirmation of facts may be requested regarding the eligibility for application.
- 5) All submitted documents will not be returned.

- A. Unable to apply for more than two recruitment units.
- B. Double citizenship and stateless persons are not recognized as foreigners.
- C. If the applicant's name is different from the application document, a certificate of the court of the relevant country proving that he/she is the same person shall be attached.
- D. Acceptance (admission) cancellation if it is found that the documents were forged, altered, or entered illegally.
- E. New or transferred students are not allowed to take a leave of absence in the first semester after admission.
- F. Department and recruitment screening cannot be changed after application of document screening (subjects can be changed from one year after admission)
- G. Do not return the submitted documents.
- H. If a tuition fee is requested to be returned due to cancellation of admission after payment of the tuition fee, the return fee shall be borne by the principal.
- I. Matters not specified in the recruitment guidelines shall be determined and implemented by the university.
- J. Applicant who does not have TOPIK certificate but applies for 85th TOPIK, can apply for this semester only if report card of 85th TOPIK, is submitted by e-mail right after the date of the report announcement. (Submit the original later)
- K. Applicants who do not possess TOPIK must take the CU-TOPIK hosted by Chosun University, and CU-TOPIK (Level 3) score of 60 or higher is recognized.
- L. Details may be changed in the future according to the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Education's support measures related to COVID-19.
- M. Please fill out the exact contact information (email, phone number, address, etc.). In the case where the pass is canceled due to the failure of various notifications, all responsibility lies with the applicant himself/herself.
- N. After admission, language requirements such as TOPIK level 5 or higher must be met to obtain a degree.
